

Camp Geronimo Checklist

Label ALL items with your first initial and last name or initials

Camping Equipment:

- Sleeping bag
- Foam pad, air mattress (twin) or cot
- Pillow
- Flashlight or headlamp with batteries
- Canteen or hydration pack
- Folding camp chair
- Backpack (* see note 1 below)
- Storage trunk (** see note 2 below)

Clothes

- Underwear (4 or more)
- Socks (4 or more)
- Pants (2)
- Shorts (2)
- Light shirt (4)
- Heavy shirt (1)
- Swimsuit and towel
- Jacket
- Sleeping clothes
- Hat
- Hiking boots
- Sneakers
- Rain poncho

Other items

- Scout Handbook
- BSA Medical form
- Parental consent form
- Patrol flag and stand

Personal items

- Toothbrush
- Toothpaste
- Medications (Inform adult leader)
- Sunscreen
- Bug spray
- Deodorant
- Lip Balm
- Comb or brush
- Soap and shampoo
- Wash cloth and towel
- Personal first aid kit

Optional items

- Camera
- Notepad/pencil
- Sun glasses
- Frisbee, football or other activity
- Spending money (~\$35)
- Snacks/Trail mix
- Watch (to get to class on time)

Scout Uniform

- Scout shirt with all patches
- Neckerchief with slide
- Scout pants or shorts
- Scout Belt
- Scout socks (if wearing scout shorts)
- Troop 222 class B shirt

The following items are NOT allowed at camp: Electronic devices, including cell phones, radio/tape/CD/MP3 players, water balloons or launchers, sling shots or wrist rockets, fireworks, sheath knives, weapons, two-way radios, skateboards/roller blades

***Note 1:** The backpack will be used for transporting clothes from the parking area to the campsite. This does not have to be a hiking backpack, but it has to large enough to hold all of his clothes. This is required by all scouts to earn Big G Gold.

****Note 2:** This will be used to store the scout's personal items in their tent. A clean, organized tent is required to pass campsite inspection. This trunk can be found in the automotive section at Wal-Mart.
